FEBRUARY 21, 2021 FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT

Jesus invites us to an exciting journey. "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God has come near: repent and believe in the Good News." We are not invited to a trip to Disneyland, Maui, or Mexico (bad example in these Covid times). Rather, we are called to explore the great depths of God's Kingdom which is close at hand, which is here and now, waiting for us to move in and live God's Spirit. We are invited to change to go into the desert or basement of our lives and ask some particularly important questions. Questions like, am I living a life worthy of my calling? Am I an ambassador for Christ? Do I love like I should love?

Well, if you find yourself stuck, at a dead-end street and wondering where to go may I suggest you take a chance on God? Jesus was driven into the desert to seek, clarify and gain focus. Lent is our time to seek, clarify and "as Jean Allen writes..." the place for is to recognize and be able to let go of everything that we have mistaken for the face of God. Just let it go!! Pope Francis says Jesus never tires of wanting to bestow his mercy on us and forgiving us. It is our opportunity to leave behind the things, behaviors and habits that hold us captive. It is now or never!!

There are always two sides to starting over: an attractive one and a frightening one. Most people enjoy beginning anew, whether it is getting married, welcoming a child into the family, starting new work, meeting new friends... these can all be exciting experiences. But new beginnings can also be frightening, because usually they involve risks. New beginnings call us from our familiar, comfortable world into unknown territory. We hesitate when we must break new ground. Wherever we stand with our response to God's choice of us, Lent is the time to measure it. We are summoned to reconsider our baptismal beginnings, to rededicate ourselves to a continuing conversion. For what is conversion but our progressive acceptance of God's choice for us? Our ever-increasing acceptance of that choice will make us into new and women, into Easter people. This is the Easter hope and the Lenten possibility. "Repentance" is turning our ordered, "that's how it's always been done" lives around to embrace the Word Jesus

proclaims ... today. We are called to live in a kingdom "not of this world", not because creation is "evil", or we are "sinful", but because Jesus offers us something better. Jesus calls us to life, to live in the Kingdom of God and to choose to embrace the Beatitudes he taught us. So, this Lent, let us give up anger, and turn to compassion, let us give up possessiveness, and turn to sharing, let us give up being self-centered, and turn to community, let us give up our grudges and hard feelings, and turn to loving. Let us give up all, and treasure God's kingdom! This is the time of fulfillment.

The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel. Father William


